- Boundary Pack 115HD - Red
 - Tent - 4 season – dark blue & red sack
 - Stakes
 - Guy-line
 - Gear-loft
 - Ground-cloth

 - Anti-bacterial wipes – in same zip-loc as toothbrush
 - Lotion – in same zip-loc as toothbrush
 - Lip balm – in same zip-loc as toothbrush
 - Pak-towel
- Cooking – tan stuff sack
 - Spices – in double zip-loc
 - Small hot sauce – in same zip-loc as spices
 - Olive oil – 4oz. – in same zip-loc as spices
 - Rubber spatula – in same zip-loc as spices
 - Biodegradable soap – 4oz. – in zip-loc
 - Sponge - in same zip - loc as soap
 - Anti-bacterial wipes – in zip-loc
 - Pak-towel
- Miscellaneous – purple stuff sack
 - 9 AA batteries – in zip-loc
 - 2 lighters – in same zip-loc as batteries
 - 2 candles – in same zip-loc as batteries
 - Bootlaces – in same zip-loc as batteries
 - Candle lantern – in neoprene cocoon – containing one candle
 - Fire starter – in zip-loc
 - 14 regular
 - 7 trioxphane
 - 4 large Ziplocs
 - 4 small Ziplocs
 - Tent repair kit – in nylon - pouch
- Entertainment – black stuff sack
 - Cheap throwing knives – in cheap leather sheath
 - Backgammon / chess set – in dark brown stuff sack
 - Book – in ziploc

- Food Bag – Large Black Stuff Sack
 - 40 ‘ nylon rope
 - 50’ nylon cord
 - Anti Animal Food Container –
 - 6 freeze dried dinners – mountain house 20oz

 - Beef Stroganoff
 - Chicken a la King w/ noodles
 - Beverage – in zip-loc
 - 12 packs of cider
 - 12 packs of tea
 - Breakfast
 - 4 freeze dried - Mountain House 10 oz.

 - mac & cheese
 - spaghetti
 - turkey tetrazzini
 - 1 dehydrated vegetable – in zip-loc
 - 1 dehydrated salsa – in same zip-loc as vegetable
 - 6 cup of soup – chicken noodle – in same zip-loc as vegetable
 - 7 coffee packs – in zip-loc
 - 14 sugar packets – in same zip-loc as coffee
 - 14 creamer packets – in same zip-loc as coffe
 - 2 small spam – in double zip-loc
 - Lunch
 - 7 individually zip-locked lunch packs, which contain:
 - 1 power bar
 - crackers and cheese
 - 1 small M&M package
 - 2 beef jerky sticks
 - 1 granola bars
 - Snack – all contained in same extra large zip-loc
 - Fish breading – double zip-locked
 - 2 packages of summer sausage – double zip-locked
 - 1 cheese block – smoky gouda – double zip-locked

- Clothes – Large Yellow Stuff Sack
 - Dirty clothes bag – large yellow stuff sack
 - 1 swim trunks – in zip-loc
 - 1 camp slippers
 - 3 pair backpacking socks – in extra large zip-loc
 - 2 pair heavy camp socks – in same zip-loc as backpacking socks
 - 1 pair neoprene water socks
 - 3 boxers – in extra large zip-loc
 - 1 heavy, non-cotton, long underwear bottom – in same zip-loc as boxers
 - 1 heavy, non-cotton, long underwear top - in same zip-loc as boxers
 - 1 light, non- cotton, long underwear bottom – in same zip-loc as boxers
 - 1 light, non-cotton, long underwear top – in same zip-loc as boxers
 - 1 camp pant (heavy fleece)
 - 1 non-cotton camp shirt (heavy)
 - 1 non-cotton long sleeve camp shirt (light)
 - 1 non-cotton long sleeve shirt (light)
 - 2 light and non-cotton pants
 - 2 light, non-cotton, short sleeve, tee shirt
 - Fleece gloves
 - Fleece hat
 - Light-weight and non-cotton jacket

I strongly recommend that we carry doubles of some items. This will serve to make chores such as water filtering & cooking less burdensome on one person and ensure that we should have at least one working piece of equipment. Other items that we should have doubles of are for the comfort of all.

- Fuel bottles and fuel **** everybody needs (approx 20 -30 oz.)
- Trash-bags or containers (please makes sure they are strong and as air-tight as possible) **** everybody needs
- Animal Proof Food Container (bear, mice) **** everybody needs
- 2 nylon ropes (30' -50 ') and large bag to hold food container **** everybody needs
- Water filter
- Stove
- Pots
- Dromedary Bag
- Rain Tarp w/ guy-lines (depending on weather forecast)
- First-aid kit
